

## **BYLAW 5 – ZONES, Boundaries**

- 5.01** The Zones of the GELC can and may be changed at a regular meeting of the GELC Board of Directors, as required, with the agreement of the affected members.

With the discussion that has taken place there has been a request for clarification for zone registrars for the upcoming season to have a map that clarifies the boundaries.

The boundaries shall be as follows:

The City of Edmonton will be divided into three zones:

The West Edmonton Blues shall be responsible for the area north of the North Saskatchewan River to the City of Edmonton limits on the west side of St. Albert Trail. The Boundaries of the West Edmonton Blues shall extend to thru Parkland County to Highway 60, as the western boundary.

The South Edmonton Warriors shall be responsible for the area south of the North Saskatchewan River, to the City of Edmonton limits on West, South and East sides.

The North Edmonton Wizards shall be responsible for the area north of the North Saskatchewan River to the City of Edmonton limits on the east side of St. Albert Trail. The boundaries of the Wizards Shall include the military housing at Namao.

The other member zones shall be divided as follows:

The Sherwood Park Titans shall be responsible for the county of Strathcona.

The Fort Saskatchewan Rebels shall be responsible for all areas from Fort Saskatchewan and north such as Gibbons and Redwater.

The Leduc Crush shall be responsible for the City of Leduc and surrounding area, including such communities as Calmar, Thorsby and Millet, and the rural municipalities surrounding Leduc.

The St. Albert Rams shall be responsible for the city of St. Albert, and such communities as Morinville, River Qui Barre and Legal, and the rural municipalities surrounding St. Albert.

The Westlock Rock shall be responsible for the community of Westlock, Barrhead and surrounding municipalities.

The residents of the Community of Beaumont while currently hosting girl's lacrosse under the auspices of the Leduc Crush may chose to become a member of either the South Edmonton Warriors or the Leduc Crush.

Residents of the Community of Devon may participate with the Leduc Crush.

Residents of Spruce Grove and Stony Plain, and the rural municipalities surrounding them may participate in the club in which they have been a member in the past, or may request of the West Edmonton Blues that from mini tyke thru Pee Wee that they be allowed to participate on a Parkland team.

If and when a Parkland Association is established the western boundary of the Blues Lacrosse Club would be highway 60 North of the the South Saskatchewan River.
