



Fundraising/Volunteer Deposits

This year Crossfield Minor Hockey asked for \$100 volunteer cheques for each player. The purpose of this money was to entice more people to assist with fundraising for the ASSOCIATION. There were three options that were given for the 2008-09 season. These options were working the Casino, working a Flames game selling 50/50 tickets or assisting with the WWHL Strathmore Rockies vs. Minnesota Whitecaps game. If you participated in one of these events, then your \$100 cheque has been returned. If you did not participate, then your cheque has been cashed with the money going to Crossfield Minor Hockey.

There seems to have been some confusion that if you worked the score clock or kept the score sheet during one of your child's games, then you would receive your money back. That is incorrect. Those are obligations to your team, not the association.

Each year there are fee increases that CMHA is obligated to pay. One example of these fees are ice rentals. We do not set these fees. These fees are set every year by the Arena Board. In order to cover our fees, we must raise our registration fees. To avoid extremely large increases to your registration fees, we have tried to supplement this with fundraising. The fundraising events bring in money for our association to cover our fees and thus, try to keep your registration fees at an acceptable level.
