Chill win 3-0 setting record with 9 straight wins



WEST DES MOINES, IO – JULY 4, 2008 – July 4, 2008 – The 2008 season didn't have the jump the Chill were hoping when they tied and lost in Thunder Bay to the Des Moines Menace; however, since that time the Chill have pushed forward with 9 straight wins including tonight. "The Des Moines Series in Thunder Bay was an early wake up call for us but we have responded positively as a team since then," replied Coach Colistro.

The Chill pushed its win streak to nine tonight, downing the Menace 3-0 in front of 3,465 Valley Stadium fans. The Menace organization put on quite a show as they always do. The game finished with a wonderful display of fireworks to celebrate the American holiday.



The Chill jumped out to a 2-0-half-time lead tonight, thanks to scores from Brandon Swartzendruber (a header in the 15th minute, assisted by Nolan Intermoia) and Wilson Neto (36th minute, unassisted).

It looked like the Menace had cut into the lead early in the second half. However, in the 47th minute, Cody Reinberg's apparent goal was waved off as it hit the football crossbar before the ball re-entered the field.

The Chill's final tally came in stoppage time when Nolan Intermoia assisted Brandon Swartzendruber on a breakaway goal for his 7th of the season.
