

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. What night does my child play?** Game nights for travel teams cannot be determined until mid-April. Game nights for teams playing in-house are as follows:
 - U4 – Saturdays from 9:00 – 10:30am, alternating between Beeton & Tottenham
 - U5 – Saturdays from 9:00 – 10:30am, alternating between Beeton & Tottenham
 - U6 - Monday & Thursday evenings, 1 game night & 1 practice night
 - U7/8 Boys & Girls – Monday & Wednesday
 - U9/10 Boys & Girls – Tuesday & Thursday

When will we be notified of a start date?

- U4, U5, U6 – Should receive calls the week of May 19th
- U7/8 – U18 – Should receive calls between May 4th and 10th.

- 2. What does my registration fee cover?** The club supplies all players with a jersey, shorts, socks and a soccer ball. We also provide a year end wrap up for all ages, team and individual photos, a tournament for U6- U10 and a tournament for U11 – U18.
- 3. What do I need to supply for my child to play soccer?** Shin pads are mandatory and soccer cleats are recommended. You should also always provide a drink for your child at both games and practices.
- 5. How do I determine which division my child will play in?**
If your child is born in:
 - 2004 U4 1996 U12
 - 2003 U5 1995 U13
 - 2002 U6 1994 U14
 - 2001 U7 1993 U15
 - 2000 U8 1992 U16
 - 1999 U9 1991 U17
 - 1998 U10 1990 U18
 - 1997 U11

- 6. How much travel is involved in the travel league (SCYSL)?** A season is made up of about 15 games. Half of these games will be played at home. Participating clubs can include as an example Cookstown, Barrie, Innisfil, Wasaga Beach, Orillia and Bracebridge. Not all teams travel to the same centres.
- 7. If I missed all registration dates how can I register my child?** You can pick up registration forms at the Tottenham Cleaners in the Tottenham Mall or at Beeton Express in the Beeton Plaza and follow instructions included with the registration form.
- 8. Can my child be on the same team as his/her friend?** Once your child reaches U6 we cannot accommodate placing friends on the same team. We try very hard to balance teams based on players' abilities. It is very likely you will know someone on the team.
- 9. Can my child play if he/she was born in 2005?** No, we do not accept registrations for any child born after Dec. 31 2004. There is no exception to this rule.
