

Quiet Thunder Soccer Club starts youth program for 2008

Starting in late June of 2008 the Quiet Thunder Soccer Club will add youth soccer to its already well-established senior program. The club will be running a mini program consisting of two age groups, U6 and U8. The program will run on Monday nights from 6:30-7:30pm at the new Park View Community soccer field in Bridgewater. At the beginning of the program, each child will receive a uniform and a ball for their use until the end of the season. Also upon registration parents will receive a pamphlet that will layout each night from week one through the eighth and final week to help them follow along with their child's progress. The program will be based on the development of soccer skills through fun and creative activities. Each age group will have a Head Coach as well as at least one assistant coach. All coaches involved in the program will have the Soccer Nova Scotia Mini Coaching certificate as well as an extensive soccer background. The Head Coaches for each age group have already been determined and both have coached youth soccer in the past and will provide a high level of soccer knowledge as well as a lot of fun for the kids involved. With an eye on keeping a small player to coach ratio the registration numbers for the program will be limited and spaces will be available on a first come first serve basis.
