Registration Fee Non-payment Policy

Okotoks Minor Ball Association (hereafter referred to as OMBA) has found it necessary to implement a policy that addresses the non-payment of registration fees.

OMBA is a not for profit organization, with its main source of income coming from registration fees. The registration fees collected are used to pay for equipment, field rental, uniforms, umpire fees, registration with provincial associations (such as Baseball Alberta, Alberta Amateur Softball, etc), player and volunteer insurance, etc.

This policy is intended to fairly deal with the non-payment of registration fees while not placing additional financial burden on OMBA association members in good standing.

OMBA defines non-payment of registration fees as: Registration fees not paid in full for either the current or previous seasons by a non sufficient funds (NSF) cheque or for any other reason, including Stop Payment of cheque.

In the event that registration fees for a player from a previous year have not been paid in full, the player will be ineligible for tryouts, registration or play until the registration fees for the previous and current years have been paid in full. Additionally, the payment of outstanding fees will only be accepted in the form of cash or certified cheque.

If a member of OMBA finds themselves in a situation where payment of fees are a financial burden, a written request to the OMBA Executive may be made requesting that terms for payment be arranged or alternate funding be explored.

The OMBA Executive will review each case on an individual basis. The final decision on request for payment terms will be made by the OMBA Executive.
